Test Procedure

Drop Count

Peracetic Acid (PAA) Test Kit KS-0099B

- 1 Drop = 13 ppm PAA
- 1. Fill the graduated reaction vial (PS-1060) to 10 mL with the water sample.
- 2. Add 10 drops of KI solution (RS-0005) and mix by swirling.
- 3. Add 10 drops of Phosphoric Acid Reagent (RS-0012) and mix by swirling.
- 4. Add 5 drops of Starch Indicator Solution (RS-0008) and mix by swirling. The solution will turn brown.
- 5. Titrate with Sodium Thiosulfate 0.10 N (RS-0002), drop by drop, mixing after each drop until the sample turns colorless passing through blue.
